

RULES TO BE FOLLOWED

- 1.** The duration of the exam is 150 minutes.
- 2.** It is forbidden to leave the examination hall for any reason during the exam. Even if you complete the test, you cannot leave the exam hall within the first 30 and the last 15 minutes of the exam. No candidate is taken to the test after the first 30 minutes following the start of the exam.
- 3.** The candidate who leaves the exam hall by submitting the exam booklet will not be taken again for whatever reason.
- 4.** It is forbidden to talk and ask questions to officers during the exam. In the same way, it is forbidden for officers to talk to the examinees closely with low voice. Also, candidates are strictly prohibited from asking each other for pen, erasers, etc.
- 5.** During the examination, you must comply with all kinds of warnings of the officers. Officers can also change your seat if necessary. Your exam is considered valid, depends on your compliance with the exam rules. If you do not comply with the rules and do not comply with the warnings, your identity will be written in the report and your exam will be invalid.
- 6.** In the following cases, the examination officers shall prepare an Examination Report and the exams of the relevant applicants for that session shall be invalid:
 - a)** Bringing the followings with you to the exam hall; documents including paper, books, notebooks, notes etc; communication, storage, and recording and data transmission devices including compass, angle meter, ruler, mobile phone, computer, calculator, tablet, radio, camera, etc.; and weapons and objects like weapons even if they are licensed or official,
 - b)** Having a calculator and/or using it,
 - c)** Sharing tools and equipment such as pen, eraser, etc. during the exam,
 - d)** Writing answers outside the answer sheet and taking them out of the exam hall,
 - e)** Participating in the exam even in the case of missing the documents required to enter the examination, and marking the answer sheet,
 - f)** Suspicion of the identity of the student by officers,
 - g)** Not handing in the answer sheet and/or question booklet to officers completely and firmly, and taking them out of the examination hall.
- 7.** If, during the test anyone is found cheating, trying to cheat, or helping someone else to cheat, his/her name and application number will be recorded, and his/her answer

sheet will not be considered for evaluation. The officers do not have to warn candidate(s) about their act of cheating. This is the candidates' responsibility. During the examination, it is extremely important that you pay attention for not letting your answer sheet be seen by another candidate.

8. It is important to fill in the necessary places on the answer sheet. You must use only a soft lead pencil for writing your name and other information or marking answers. Pen cannot be used. Mark your answers only on the answer sheet. For each question mark one letter (A, B, C, D, or E) on your answer sheet. Answers marked only in the question booklet will be ignored.

9. Once you receive the question booklet, you advised that checking it throughout and make sure that no pages are missing and all pages are readable. If your question booklet page is missing or printing is incorrect, contact the officer immediately to replace it. Check whether the letter printed at the top of each page in the question booklet is the same as the letter printed on the cover. If you realise any differences, you should ask officer for a new question booklet. If you realised this later on, contact the officers for the other booklet. Your answers until that point will be considered based on the actual booklet type. Do not forget to mark your type of booklet on the answer sheet. If you missed to mark you're booklet type on the answer sheet, your exam will be invalid, since it will not be possible to evaluate it.

10. You may use the blank spaces on the pages of the question booklet as scrap paper for writing.

11. No one, including officer in charge, is allowed to smoke cigarette, or any other tobacco products during the examination.

12. It is strictly forbidden to make a record of your answers on any paper and take it out.

13. The wrong answers will not decrease the number of your correct answers. Therefore, you are encouraged to answer all questions as this could be better for you.

14. There is only one correct answer for each question. If you mark multiple answers for a question, you will be deemed to have answered that question incorrectly.

15. Before leaving the exam hall, make sure to hand over your question booklet and answer sheet to the officers.
